



Terrorists Continue To Use Technology Against Us. New Book Reveals The Vulnerabilities Of The Global Information Infrastructure And Its Use By Terrorist Groups.

Much of this book is dedicated to illustrating the use of the Global Information Infrastructure by terrorists for the communication and coordination of terrorist cells, the gathering of target intelligence, and the use of cyber criminal activities as a force multiplier for both physical attacks and infrastructure destabilization. "The Global Information Infrastructure is the new supply chain for terrorist organizations such as al Qaeda and its supporters. CYBER TERRORISM: Political and Economic Implications identifies seven initiatives towards securing it from terrorists and cyber criminals alike" added Dr. Colarik.
